- 4. TREE PLANTING IN DEBS PARK** Long time Debs Park supporter/Montecito Heights resident Thomas Berg seeks support for a tree planting in the south end of Debs Park near where the murdered girls were found. This supplements trees planted 20 years ago in a public event with a mariachi band and refreshments. Irrigation already in place. The Debs Park Advisory Board has endorsed the idea. Audubon Center will contribute plant material. Assemblymember Jimmy Gomez will also donate. NPG/CIP budget not yet determined.
- 5. AMP/JOSH BUCK NPG** of \$1500 for youth activities. Date, location and ASNC's role to be determined.
- 6. EVENT CHECKLIST** Form to track volunteers, equipment and logistics for ASNC events. Valerie, Teri and Tamar to collaborate.
- 7. INVENTORY OF STORAGE CONTENTS** Summary of equipment and promotional items at Storquest.

New Items

- 8. PET EVENT** Request up to \$1000 for flyer, water, coffee, pan dulce and promo items including portable water bowls and poop bags. Determine date and details.
